Morris County's Most Dangerous Roads

11 pedestrians were killed on Morris County streets in the three years from 2007 through 2009. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveal that US-46 suffered the highest number of pedestrian deaths over the period.


