

Passaic County's Most Dangerous Roads

27 pedestrians were killed on Passaic County streets in the three years from 2007 through 2009. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveal that Hamburg Turnpike suffered the highest number of pedestrian deaths over the period.

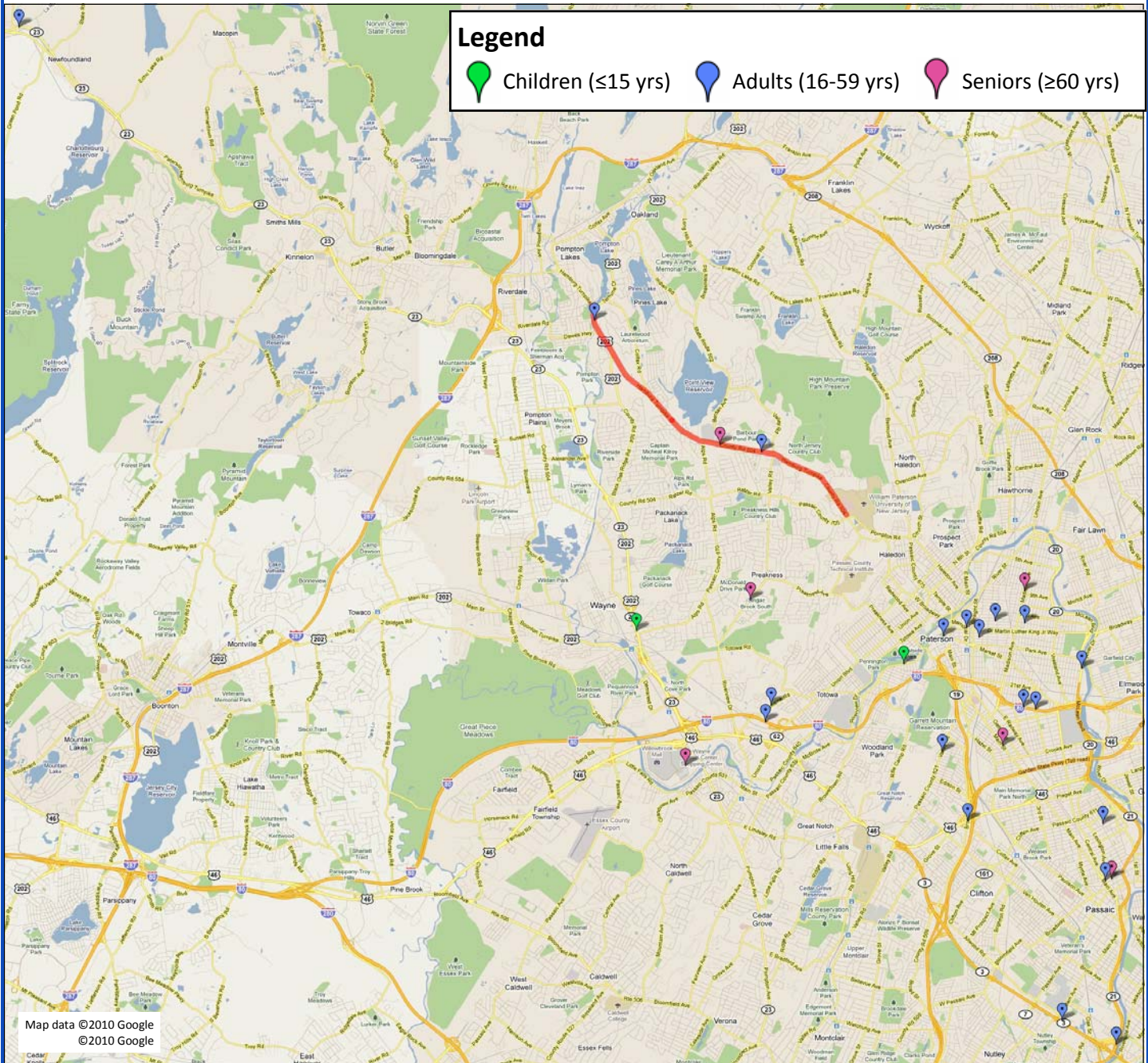
