# Gloucester County's Most Dangerous Roads

14 pedestrians were killed on Gloucester County streets in the three years from 2008 through 2010. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveals that US-322 suffered the highest number of pedestrian deaths over the period.




## Location of Gloucester County Pedestrian Fatalities, 2008-2010
