Ocean County's Most Dangerous Roads

32 pedestrians were killed on Ocean County streets in the three years from 2008 through 2010. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveals that Route 9 and Route 549 suffered the highest number of pedestrian deaths over the period.


