## Orange County's Most Dangerous Roads


14 pedestrians were killed on Orange County roads in the three years from 2009 through 2011. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveals that Newburgh had two pedestrian fatalities over the period studied.
