# THE REGION'S MOST DANGEROUS ROADS FOR WALKING Essex County

**57 pedestrians were killed on Essex County roads** in the three years from 2010 through 2012. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveals that Route 21 (McCarter Highway) and Route 508 had the highest number of pedestrian deaths over the period studied.


