## THE REGION'S MOST DANGEROUS ROADS FOR WALKING Westchester County

**23 pedestrians were killed on Westchester County roads** in the three years from 2010 through 2012. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveals that Yonkers had four pedestrian fatalities over the period studied, while New Rochelle and Yorktown Heights had three each.


