50 people were killed on Essex County roads in the three years from 2012 through 2014. Tri-State Transportation Campaign's analysis of federal traffic fatality data reveals that Grove Street (CR-509) and McCarter Highway (SR-21) had the highest number of pedestrian deaths over the period studied.


