OUR CURRENT CAMPAIGNS

Alfresco NYC

Ensuring that Open Restaurants and Open Streets programs are accessible to all New Yorkers, beneficial for the local communities, and sustainable in the long term. We are celebrating street life in New York City, providing information to businesses and community groups, and working to expand these programs to more neighborhoods.

Bus Turnaround

The Bus Turnaround Coalition is a diverse group of New York organizations determined to turn around the poor service that plagues New York City's bus system and the more than 2 million rides taken on it every weekday. We are winning increased attention from our leaders and great resources for high quality, fast, and reliable bus service for all neighborhoods in the city.

Fix Our Transit

Fix Our Transit is a coalition of over 100 transportation, environmental, business, labor, clergy, public health and justice organizations that fully back congestion pricing in Manhattan, south of 59th Street. Congestion pricing will reduce traffic gridlock, cut tailpipe emissions, and generate revenue for New York's Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA).

ElectrifyNY

ElectrifyNY is a coalition of advocates for environmental justice, public transit, social justice, and good jobs, fighting for a clean, equitable electric transportation future for New York. Our work aims to improve the environment and public health outcomes for communities most affected by the negative impacts of the transportation sector's dependency on fossil fuels.

Build Gateway Now

Build Gateway Now is a coalition of civic, labor and business leaders building support for the construction of a new rail tunnel to connect New York, New Jersey, and the entire Northeast Corridor.

Circuit Trails Coalition

The Circuit Trails Coalition is a collaboration of non-profit organizations, foundations, and agencies working to advance completion of a connected network of trails – the Circuit Trails – in the Greater Philadelphia region. Their goal is to raise the profile and public benefits of bicycle and pedestrian trails so that building the Circuit Trails becomes a significant regional priority.

#BetterBeeLine Bus Campaign

The Bee-Line Bus Campaign was launched in 2021 to raise awareness about issues facing the majority of Westchester County bus riders, such as unreliable service, antiquated infrastructure, outdated bus routes, and the need for modern passenger amenities both onboard buses and at bus stops.

NJ Bus Campaign

The NJ Bus Campaign was launched in 2018 to raise awareness about issues facing the majority of NJ Transit's riders, such as unreliable service, antiquated infrastructure, outdated bus routes, and the need for modern passenger amenities both onboard buses and at bus stops.

Complete & Green Streets

TSTC launched this campaign in 2016 to develop a Model Complete Streets Policy that incorporated Green Streets and multiple benefits of smart road design: equity, health, safety, economy and the environment. The effort to create this policy was spearheaded by TSTC and included multiple diverse stakeholders from the health, equity, environment, safety, government and private sector.

ElectrifyNJ

ElectrifyNJ is a statewide coalition of advocates for environmental justice, public transportation, social justice, and good jobs fighting for a clean, equitable electric transportation future for New Jersey. Our work aims to improve the environment and public health outcomes for the communities most affected by the negative impacts of the transportation sector's dependency on fossil fuels.

Vision Zero NJ Alliance

The Vision Zero Alliance is a coalition of diverse partners, such as families impacted by traffic crashes, community members, advocates, policymakers, transportation professionals, public health professionals, and others. Vision Zero starts with the belief that every person in

New Jersey will be able to travel safely each day, without the risk of death or serious injuries on our roadways, no matter how or when they travel.
